



## **Virksund Sailing Club invites the Yngling class to the Summer Regatta**

25–26 July 2026

Virksund Sailing Club invites the Yngling class to a summer regatta in the Limfjord. The event is an ideal opportunity for both crew and boat to fine-tune the last details before the autumn regattas – and not least the World Championship in Bergen in Norway.

The regatta will be held from Virksund Marina, and the races on Saturday 25 July and Sunday 26 July will take place in Lovns Bredning in the Limfjord, which is known for stable wind conditions and excellent racing courses.

### **Sailing Area – Lovns Bredning**

The races will be held in Lovns Bredning, which is one of the Limfjord's best racing areas.

The area is known for:

- Stable wind conditions.
- Open waters with excellent course options.
- Short distances from harbour to course.
- Good conditions for both sailors and race management.

### **Registration**

The summer regatta at Virksund Sailing Club is open for registration.

Entry fee per crew: 950 DKK or 130 Euros.

## **Sailing Instructions**

The summer regatta will be conducted according to World Sailing's International Racing Rules.

Sailing Instructions will be published in Manage2Sail and will not be handed out at registration.

## **Arrival in Virksund**

The Race Office will be open from Friday, 24 July at 12:00.

Upon arrival at Virksund Marina, crews must register at the Race Office.

Crane assistance for launching Yngling boats will be available from Friday, 24 July.

## **Accommodation**

There are several options for overnight accommodation in the area, including:

- Virksund Camping
- Airbnb in the local area

Changing and bathing facilities can be found in the club house at Virksund Marina as well as at the campsites.

As part of the regatta, all sailors are invited to a social event on Saturday evening at the clubhouse.

There will be a communal dinner, an opportunity to share stories from the day's races, and a chance to enjoy the social atmosphere with other Yngling sailors.

Virksund is known for its cosy and informal atmosphere, where both competitive sailing and socialising are in focus.

## **Berths**

During the regatta, berths will be reserved in Virksund Marina for the Yngling class boats.

## **Trailer and Parking Facilities**

There will be the possibility to park trailers near the harbour during the regatta.

Further information about the location of trailer parking will be provided upon arrival at the regatta office.

## **Spectators**

It is possible to follow the races from land at several places in the area, including:

These locations offer good opportunities to watch the regattas from the shore.

## **After the regatta**

The boats will be taken ashore immediately after the event on Sunday, 26 July.

There will be an opportunity to leave the boats at the slipway in Virksund until the weekend of 1–2 August 2026. This may be a convenient option if the boat and crew are going to the World Championships in Bergen in August.
